Born in Rome in 1995, Alessandro graduated in 2019 in Aeronautical Engineering at «Sapienza University of Rome». Thanks to the European program of abroad thesis, he wrote his master thesis at Delft University of Technology in the Netherlands working on small cooperative satellites for radar imaging.

Right after the graduation he moved to France to work as Flight Laws Engineer in Airbus.

In January 2020 he returned to Turin to begin a Master in Business Administration at the Collège des Ingénieurs Italia, thanks to which he became a CIM4.0 collaborator, alternating periods of work with study weeks (in a ratio of around 70-30), at the CDI offices in Paris, Munich and Turin and at CERN in Geneva.

In January 2021 he moved to Delft University of Technology to pursue a Doctor of Philosophy in the field of military VTOL (Vertical Takeoff and Landing) UAV (Unmanned Aerial Vehicle).
